1. Volunteer's name and work preference: Volunteer Name: Last name. first name

Contact Info: E-mail address and cell phone number

Day: Saturday, Sunday, or No Preference **Shift:** Morning, Afternoon or No Preference

Work Location: Name of booth or No Preference

Special needs: Such as "requires seat during shift", "must work with another person" (name).

(example: Jane Doe: jdoe@yahee.com, 707-983-0000, Sat. May 3, afternoon shift, ticket booth, must work with husband John Doe

- **2.** Include a note* if volunteer has already committed to serve at a specific time, location, etc. (example: Bob Smith: Sun. May 4, morning shift, kids area, *previously confirmed)
- **3**. If a volunteer needs to cancel, they should immediately contact Janet Moore or Shona Weir by text or email so we can find a replacement. Use our cell phone numbers if the cancellation is within 24 hours of the Festival.
- **4.** All volunteers must sign in at the **North Gate** (also the "Volunteer Check-in" Gate). Your organization will only get credit for hours worked when volunteers sign in at this gate. All shifts are 4 hours.

Please note the following:

VOLUNTEERS

- Must be 14 years or older.
- Make sure to arrive 15 minutes before your shift to make for an easy transition
- All shifts are 4 hours.
- If your children or pets come to the Festival, please have someone else be responsible for them during your volunteer shift.
- Bodega Bay weather is unpredictable. We recommend dressing in layers and wear comfortable shoes.
- We suggest you bring drinking water in a refillable water bottle.
- CHECK IN and OUT AT NORTH GATE/VOLUNTEER GATE.
- If you need to cancel, please contact Janet Moore or Shona Weir immediately by text or email. If the cancellation is within 24 hours of the Festival, please telephone us asap using the contact info shown below.

ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES

Please *do not* bring alcoholic beverages into the Festival as our liquor license prohibits this. All alcoholic beverages consumed at the Festival must be purchased from the on-site Wine and/or Beverage Booths.
