RE: VOLUNTEER LISTS

When submitting your volunteer list, please indicate which day, shift and place the volunteer prefers to work. If the volunteer has no preference, please indicate that. Also, please list if they have someone they must work with.

These are some of the problems I have encountered when assigning the volunteers and it is so much easier if I know these things before I assign them and then have to change it after. The more information I can get ahead of time, the better.

Please ask each volunteer: if they have already agreed to work for a booth and if they have, I need to know which booth and what day and shift.

Please impress that if they need to cancel, I must be notified ahead of time so I can replace them and not leave the booth shorthanded. When we have “no shows”, it causes a big problem. **If they need to cancel on the day of Fish Fest after 8:00AM, my cell is (916) 712-5067.**

If anyone needs to be seated either the whole shift or part need to know this also.

The volunteers must sign in at the **North Gate** in order for the organization they may be working for to get credit.

I need your list of volunteers by April 1; the earlier, the better. Volunteers must work a 4-hour shift to get credit for their organization

Volunteer Guidelines

- Bodega Bay weather is unpredictable; therefore, dress in layers and wear comfortable shoes.
- You are advised to bring drinking water in a refillable water bottle.
- CHECK IN AT NORTH GATE.

Please do not bring alcoholic beverages into the Festival as our liquor license prohibits this. All alcoholic beverages consumed at the Festival must be purchased from the on-site Wine and/or Beverage Booths.
